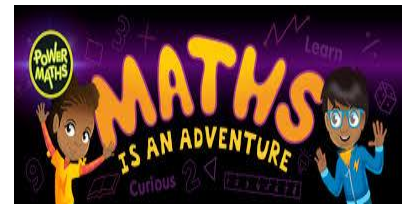
Please continue to support your child's reading and phonics practice at home.

Safeguarding

This term we will be learning about how to manage our online information safely and our online reputation.

Computing

In computing we will be exploring programming a robot using directions, mapping routes and creating algorithms.



PSHE

We will be learning and talking about who keeps us safe, sun safety and how we recognise our feelings.

Art/DT

This term we will be developing our skills in art by looking closely at Flora and Fauna and discovering how artists are inspired by what they see in nature. In DT this term we will be discovering textiles and how they can be used to create puppets.



PE
