Play snakes and ladders with your family!
Have fun and try subitising using the dots on the dice. Can you estimate how many spaces you need to move to avoid the snakes?



Go on a summer walk. How is it different from your Autumn walks? What do you notice? Talk to an adult about what is the same and what is different. Can you take long strides or short hops on your walk too?

In class we are learning about Pirates, maps and journeys. Make your own treasure map and include your house or our school. Don't forget **X** marks the spot!



Teach someone at home the rhyme 'When I was one I sucked my thumb' using your fingers to show how old you are in each part of the song.



Can you write a sentence about this picture? Try creating a story using these characters and tell an adult your story.



Make a boat from any empty containers you can find at home. Does it float or sink?
How many 2p pieces does it hold before it sinks?



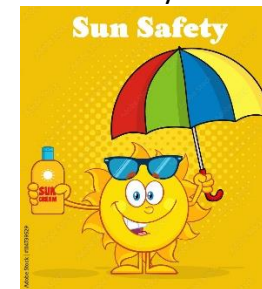
If there are 10 dragons in the forest and 1 gets lost, how many are left? Can you do the same calculation with different amounts of dragons getting lost?
eg $10-2 = 10-6 = ?$



Look at your shadow when you play outside. Is it bigger or smaller than you? Is it always there? Does it follow you in front or behind?
Tell us what you discover...



Talk to a grown up about staying safe in the sun. Can you design a poster to show what you have found out?
