You could use crayons, chalk, paint or felt tips, or even be creative using collage materials!
Can you sort some objects in different ways? How many sets can you make? You could use some of your favourite toys, buttons or lego blocks and sort by colour, size or type.	What is your favourite nursery rhyme? Draw a picture of your favourite character in your nursery rhyme, it might be Goosey Gander, Little Miss Muffet or Little Boy Blue ... www.bbcschoolradio.co.uk	Physical challenge: How many jumps or hops can you do in 30 seconds? 
Practice getting dressed and undressed independently. Try to practice zips, buttons and socks.	Look around your home very carefully. Can you find 10 objects which begin with ‘s’ ‘a’ ‘t’ or ‘p’? Ask an adult to help you write a list or draw pictures of all 10 objects.	During December you could make a Christmas decoration for our class Christmas tree.
