To improve SPaG and the application of SPaG across the school. To improve reading outcomes for the whole school and ensure there is more accelerated progress for reading at the end of KS1 (End of year analysis) and KS2 ie increase the average scaled score at the end of KS2 to be above national 2023. Implement the DFE reading framework. **To help children be the best readers they can be and that they are ready for next reading stage, in order to flourish**

To ensure the curriculum is sufficiently well planned and implemented so that pupils deepen their knowledge across all subjects. To develop the skills of all middle leaders so that they can improve the quality of teaching and standards in their areas of responsibility. **To make sure that subjects are led by staff and can support adults to ensure subjects are well taught. To make sure that all learning in other areas of the curriculum give children the opportunity to learn and build on previous learning so they can make links and understand better.**

To provide frequent opportunities for the most able pupils to deepen their understanding of the concepts being taught in mathematics. **To make sure children who adapt to maths problems quickly understand key concepts in different ways and explain these.**
